
What does a Physiotherapist do?

Who can a physiotherapist work with?

Physiotherapists can treat the following:

- ☑ Chronic respiratory conditions such as asthma, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) and bronchiectasis
- ☑ Degenerative joint diseases such as osteoarthritis
- ☑ Neurological conditions such as stroke or traumatic brain injuries
- ☑ Diseases of the central nervous system such as Parkinson's disease and cerebral palsy
- ☑ People with a diagnosed cognitive impairment such as dementia and Alzheimer's disease
- ☑ Autoimmune diseases such as rheumatoid arthritis and multiple sclerosis (MS)
- ☑ Type one and type two diabetes mellitus
- ☑ Cardiac illnesses such as coronary heart disease, heart failure or hypertension (high blood pressure)
- ✓ Incontinence issues associated with pregnancy, prostate enlargement/cancer or other age-related changes
- ☑ Vestibular conditions, balance changes and other factors contributing to frequent falls
- ☑ Mobility decline and loss of functional abilities including activities of daily living
